Current Benefits

\$5,000 Accidental Death benefit is paid when a member dies from accidental bodily injury, or exposure or loss of life due to adverse weather conditions, or disappearance for 365 days after the date of an accident.

\$5,000 Line of Duty benefit is paid in *addition* to the Accidental Death benefit when an active at work member is killed in the line of duty.

Expanded Accident Benefits are paid when a member is involved in an accident that directly results in one of the following losses:

◆ Loss of hands or feet	\$5,000	◆ Reattachment of Hand or Foot	\$2,500
◆ Loss of hand or foot	\$2,500	◆ Loss of Speech	\$2,500
◆ Loss Thumb and Index Finger of Same Hand	\$1,250	◆ Loss of Hearing (<i>both ears</i>)	\$2,500
◆ Loss of sight, both eyes	\$5,000	◆ Quadriplegia	\$5,000
◆ Loss of sight, one eye	\$2,500	◆ Paraplegia	\$2,500
		◆ Hemiplegia	\$2,500
◆ Occupational Assault benefit paid in <i>addition</i> to the Accidental Death & Line of Duty Benefits when an active at work member's loss of life occurs as the result of an act of physical violence.			\$ 2,500
◆ Seat Belt benefit paid in <i>addition</i> to other applicable benefits when a member is killed as a result of an automobile accident while properly utilizing a seat belt system, as evidenced by a police report.			\$5,000
◆ Common Carrier benefit paid in <i>addition</i> to the Accidental Death Benefit if a member is killed while riding as a fair-paying passenger on qualifying public transportation.			\$5,000
